



## **Terms and Conditions**

Walk The Woodie is a physically demanding activity and participants must only take part if they know (or should know) of no reason why they should not take part. Walk the Woodie carries with it risks and to the fullest extent permitted by Law. Blackpool Pleasure Beach Ltd accepts no liability for any loss or damage (of any kind direct or indirect) caused as a consequence of taking part and in particular no liability will be accepted for any damaged or lost personal possessions carried or taken during the Walk by a participant. The walk takes place on the Big Dipper wooden rollercoaster structure. Note: Only part of the circuit is walked during the experience. The surface can be uneven, steep, dirty and slippery. Exposed nails and both rough and sharp edges are part of the nature of a wooden rollercoaster structure. Suitable sturdy boots must be worn. Should the Walk take part in inclement weather then no warranty or guarantee is given as to a view from any position on the structure or other emotional experience.

## Participants MUST;

- 1. Be at least 12 years of age and 1.32metres in height.
- 2. Attend and understand a safety briefing before attempting the Walk, and arrive no later than 10 minutes before the stated time to start the Experience.
- 3. Understand and complete an Event Participation Agreement and if under 16 years of age have it signed by someone over 18 years on their behalf.
- 4. Not attend under the influence of alcohol or non-prescribed drugs. We reserve the right to carry out tests and a refusal to undergo a test or a failure will prevent a person from taking part.
- 5. Complete a practical training section on the lower part of the structure prior to commencing the Walk.
- 6. Comply at all times with all our instructions.
- 7. Be able to walk unaided and to hold onto a handrail on the Big Dipper and use our prescribed safety clothing and harnesses. Assistance animals are not permitted.
- 8. Not suffer from vertigo or any other illness which may affect a person's ability to climb and/or put them or others at risk of harm. Should a person be taking any medication for any condition then he/she must consult with their doctor before taking part.
- 9. Not smoke, eat or drink during the Walk.
- 10. Not cause alarm, upset or distress to any other participant during the Walk.
- 11. Not interfere with any part of the ride structure.
- 12. Not take or interfere with any article on the Walk that may interfere with safety.
- 13. Understand that Blackpool Pleasure Beach shall in its absolute discretion be entitled to refuse a person permission to take part in the Walk or require them to return to ground level at any time in the event that their safety or that of any other person is put at unnecessary risk or their behaviour is considered by the company representative present to be unacceptable.
- 14. Note that the Walk may take place in inclement weather. The structure is slippery when wet. Should the weather be such that it is too dangerous for the Walk to take place then the Walk will be cancelled. In addition should Force Majeure occur then the Walk will be cancelled. In the event of the former then an alternative date will be offered (if available) but if not and/or the latter occurs then a refund will be given. No refunds will be given in any other circumstances. It is the participants' responsibility to check if the Walk is to take place in the event of inclement weather.
- 15. During the Walk the participants MUST wear suitable sturdy footwear such as walking boots with a good grip on the soles. These are not supplied and failure to bring them will result in the person not being permitted to take part.
- 16. Produce their E-Ticket to staff upon arrival. Without this, a person will not be permitted to take part.
